The Livingston County Sheriff's Office is asking for assistance from the public in regard to a Breaking and Entering of a Hartland Township Residence.

On February 25, 2010 at or near 1050 A.M. Deputies responded to a residential burglary alarm in the area of Clyde and Fenton Road. Upon arrival it was learned that unknown subject(s) had broken into the residence and stole items from the home owner.

The suspect is believed to have been wearing Nike Air Jordan tennis shoes. Some of the following items were stolen from the residence:

1. 19 inch Insignia flat screen TV.
2. Silver chain with a silver crucifix and clear glass beads.
3. A wooden jewelry box with a rose inlay.
4. A jewelry box with a Terry Redline nature scene on the top.

The jewelry inside the boxes was family heirlooms and had great sentimental value to the owner.
