ARSON

On Saturday February 27, 2010 at approximately 7:20 PM, the Fowlerville Fire Department as well as Deputies from the Livingston County Sheriff's Department responded to a house fire at 2010 North Gregory Rd near the intersection of Judd Rd in Handy Township. Fire officials stated that the fire was suspicious in nature. Members of the Livingston County Fire Investigation Team (LCFIT) responded to the scene and an investigation revealed that the fire was intentionally set. A suspicious vehicle was seen near the home just prior to the fire. This vehicle is described as a dark colored minivan and was seen parked both on the road near the residence and in the driveway.

This case remains under investigation by the Livingston County Detective Bureau. Anyone having any information about this vehicle is asked to call Detective Jim McGinty at 517-540-7999 or contact "Arson Control" at 1-800-44-ARSON toll free.
